

Safar: Meaning 'empty', this month was named so because pre-Islamic Arabs used to leave their homes in search of food during this month. Some sources say that this name actually derived from pre-Islamic Arabs conducting raids against other tribes, leaving their home 'empty'.

Rabi al -Awwal: is the third month in the Islamic calendar and the month in which the Prophet Muhammad peace be upon him was born, died. It is also the month in which the Prophet migrated from Mecca to Medina. The word Rabi means 'spring'. Alawwal means 'the first' so together, this month means 'the first spring'.

This program allows high school students to take college-level courses while still enrolled in high school, providing them with the opportunity to earn both high school and college credits simultaneously



Hifz Weekend School provides instruction to children ages 4-18. Its objective is to provide an Islamic environment where children can learn about Islamic principles and values, including basic understanding of Islamic beliefs and practices.

In addition to Islamic Studies, emphasis is also placed on basic Arabic reading for the purposes of Quranic reading and memorization.

Children are placed in groups according to their ages and abilities. The groups are from levels 1 - 5, including kindergarten.


